





- 2. More reliability: a new concentric float carburetor that keeps fuel flowing evenly on steep climbs or during tight, angled turns. A must for trail-busting adventure on a bike.
- 3. Just as important, on the street or in the brush, the new solid state regulator and full 12 volt electric system that keep you going. Even when the going's tough.
- **4.** Tough? Like the double down tube frame that's outfitted with a guard plate for the engine.
- 5. Something else new. Three-way adjustable rear shocks. To meet load and road conditions. And smooth out country.
- 6. Cross-braced handlebars are engineered for maximum strength. And rider comfort. In the middle, a Borletti re-set speedometer that lets you gauge mileage down to a tenth. Securely mounted to isolate it from jars and shocks.
- 7. Sleek lines that seem to make the new contoured seat and gas tank an integral unit.


